## Dear GRAPPA Member:

GRAPPA invites trainees and junior faculty—assistant professor level, medical/non-medical PhD students, junior post-docs, residents, and fellows—to submit proposals to GRAPPA to fund pilot projects related to psoriasis or psoriatic arthritis.

Projects can be in any branch of science: basic science, clinical, or translational science. Awardee and/or mentor need to be members of GRAPPA. Mentors or co-mentors must be Full GRAPPA members.

### 1 Support

---

GRAPPA will provide support for up to four projects this academic year:

- three (3) projects for USD 25,000 each – one each for basic science, clinical, or translational science
- one (1) rheumatology-dermatology collaborative project for USD 35,000

### 2 Submission Documents

---

- Short cover letter indicating title, mentor and which grant applied for.
- 3-page proposal (maximum excluding references and budget documents) including a scientific abstract, lay abstract, background, methods, expected results and significance for psoriatic disease.
- Detailed budget and budget justification.
- Curriculum vitae of applicant and brief biosketch of mentor (maximum 5 pages).
- Support letter (pdf) from their project supervisor, Chairman or Division Chief.
- Format - Documents should be single spaced, times new roman font 12 or equivalent, with page number and applicant's name at the top of each page.

**Proposals are due on March 1, 2023 (11:59 PM PT).** Awardees will be notified in early June.
