





AXIAL INVOLVEMENT IN PSORIATIC ARTHRITIS COHORT

The Axial Involvement in Psoriatic Arthritis (AXIS) study is a prospective cross-sectional study that has been conducted under the umbrella of ASAS and GRAPPA.

The overarching aim of the AXIS study is to systematically evaluate clinical and imaging manifestations indicative of axial involvement (based on local and central assessments) in patients with PsA to develop classification criteria and a unified nomenclature for axial involvement in PsA that would allow defining a homogeneous subgroup of patients for research.

Study Population includes:

- Consecutive patients diagnosed with PsA
- Fulfilling the CASPAR classification criteria for PsA
- Symptom duration of up to 10 years
- •Not receiving b- or ts- DMARDs (b- or ts- DMARDs naïve)

PATIENT ENROLLMENT STARTED:

A total of 57 centers from 21 countries have been selected for participation.

Patient enrollment has started in 9 countries. We are pleased to share that 128 patients have been enrolled so far, of which 80 patients have successfully completed eCRF and 57 patients' images have been centrally reviewed.

CONTRACTING:

17 national coordinating centers outside North America (corresponding to 44 centers) and 6 centers in North America signed the contract.

Contracting procedures are still ongoing with the other countries!

TEST MRI & ETHICS APPROVAL:

- The imaging will be the cornerstone of the the project. For this reason, in order to ensure the imaging quality, a test MRI:
 - Has been requested from 53 centers, received from 40 center, and 38 of those were approved so far!
- 15 countries have the EC/IRB approval that covers 28 centers!
- In the next steps of the project, we are waiting for each country's contracting and ethical approval procedures to be completed so that all centers can start enrolling patients.
- We'd like to underline that the inclusion of patients will be competitive and will include maximum patient numbers per center and per country!!!
